Casual Vacancy – Pendarves Ward

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 89 (6) of the Local Government Act 1972 that a Casual Vacancy exists in the office of Councillor for the Pendarves of Camborne Town Council.

The period of time allowed for electors to request an election has now passed without the appropriate number of requests received. Therefore, in accordance with Rule 8(3) of the Local Elections (Parish and Community) Rules 1986, the Town Council must now co-opt a suitably qualified person to serve as a Councillor for the aforementioned Ward. Any person wishing to be considered for co-optation should in the first instance, apply in writing to the Deputy Town Clerk & Acting Proper Officer of Camborne Town Council, stating their interest, eligibility criteria (see below) and the reasons why they believe they should be considered for one of these vacancies.

Persons eligible for consideration must be aged 18 years or over, and

- a. is and thereafter continues to be a local government elector for the Parish of Camborne; OR
- b. has during the whole of the twelve months preceding, occupied as owner or tenant, any land or other premises in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- c. your only place of work during the last twelve months has been in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- d. you have during the last twelve months resided in the Parish of Camborne; OR
- e. you have during the last twelve months resided within three miles of the Parish of Camborne.

You are ineligible to stand as a councillor if you have received, during the last five years either been given a prison sentence of

three or more months (including suspended) or have been declared bankrupt.

The closing date for the receipt of applications is 14 days from the date of this Notice (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and Bank Holidays).

Applications will be considered at Full Council on 12th November 2020, where applicants will be invited to attend.
