Councillor Chalker also presented the Town Council Certificates to Caius Simmons, Andrew Richards and Peter Smith for their outstanding work with the Townscape Heritage Initiative Project.

ATA.267 TO HEAR A PRESENTATION FROM REVEREND MARK RICHARDS CELEBRATING THE HISTORY OF CAMBORNE CRICKET CLUB AND 100 SEASONS OF LEAGUE CRICKET

Camborne Cricket Club was formed in the 1830s and had recently celebrated 100 years of competitive league cricket. The pitch was classed as the 'Lords' of Cornwall, with the most unique ground in Cornwall. Their team dominated Cornish Cricket in the 1930s and were named the Gerry Boys. The Pavilion burnt down in 1969 and was re-built in 1974 when the club purchased the ground from the Pendarves Estate.

Reverend Richards thanked the Town Council for their recent grant award which had resulted in further successful fundraising. The grant helped fund recent refurbishment of the clubs facilities. Further fundraising was needed to replace the patio, improve the disabled access, update the lighting, replace the flooring of the clubhouse, and replace the nets which were 15years old. The total fundraising to-date totalled £105,000.

The Club had four senior teams playing in different leagues. They had a strong youth section with teams through age groups under 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15 years.

Reverend Richards expressed the need to save the green spaces in Camborne for the use of future generations; he invited the Councillors to visit the club and grounds.

The Mayor thanked Reverend Richards for his interesting presentation.
