### **ATA.273 PRESENTATION OF CAMBORNE TOWN COUNCIL PLAQUE AWARDS 2017**

The Mayor presented the Town Plaque awards. The Town Clerk read out the nominations as follows:

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The first plaque to 1<sup>st</sup> Camborne Scout Group, in recognition of 100 years provision of youth facilities and activities; was received in their absence by Councillor J Barclay.

The second plaque was presented to Mrs Marie Splatt for her dedicated voluntary work for Centenary Chapel.

The third plaque was presented to Major John Holmes MBE in recognition of his service to the Camborne branch of the Royal British Legion.

### **ATA.274 TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION FROM MR MATTHEW WILLS, 3HW DESIGN AND ARCHITECTURE, REGARDING THE REFURBISHMENT OF THE PASSMORE EDWARDS LIBRARY, CAMBORNE**

In 1890 the site was occupied by a small row of 4 tenement buildings, the leases of these were purchased by the local board and the buildings were replaced with the library building commissioned by John Passmore Edwards. Mr Arthur Basset of Tehidy Estates granted a 999 year lease on the building; with a nominal rent while it was used for the purposes for which Mr Edwards intended.

On the on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2017 representatives from Camborne Town Council and 3HW hosted an event for members of the public to discuss and ask questions about the proposed changes to the building. Most changes would be to the first floor so that the Town Council can have its offices and hold all its meetings there. There were opportunities to use some of the space differently, particularly the outside courtyard, and the Council was keen to know what residents would like and think would be most valuable.

External works needed were: replacement of roof, renewal/repair of leadwork, overhaul of fascias and rainwater goods repair, redecoration of doors and windows, and repair/repointing of stonework.
