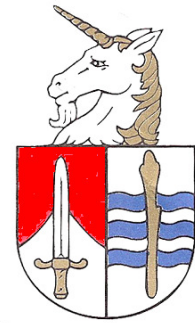

14. To approve a motion from Councillor G Taylor:

"To rescind Full Council resolution C.3167.2 'That the Town Clerk does not attend BID meetings' on the grounds of new information received in the report from Mr C Rolley 'A Root and Branch Organisational review for Camborne Town Council'.

To approve Recommendation 18 of the Root and Branch Organisational Review of Camborne Town Council 'That the Town Council should resume formal membership on the BID Camborne Board with the Town Clerk attending future meetings and elected members should work actively both formally and informally with both BID and the Camborne Chamber of Commerce in promoting the Town's business economy' and agree action accordingly.
