Members of the public spoke in support of a grant application for the Royal British Legion.

They thanked the Town Council for the donation of the WW2 commemorative seat and were planning to pave the area surrounding the seat and War Memorial as it was surrounded by rough grass. The project was to be in four phases. Kehelland Trust had provided free labour to help with phase one; for which the Legion had donated £100 to the Trust. The sponsorship of £10 per slab for memorial dedications had been set up to help finance the project. A list of the dedications would be sited in the church.
